1. **Lee Bedford**, Private 126472, 34th Battalion Canadian Regiment, 19, Newsome Place, Batley Carr. Killed 01st March 1917, Vimy Ridge.



2. **Alonza Driver**, Private 6049, 2/6 Battalion West Yorkshire Regiment, Dale St, Thornhill Lees, Dewsbury. Killed 02nd March 1917



3. **Eddie Whitworth**, Private 40477, Worcestershire Regiment, Elmwood St, Dewsbury. Killed 04th March 1917



4. **Edward Whitworth**, Private 43631, 17th West Yorkshire Regiment, Hulton House, Boothroyd Lane, Dewsbury. Killed on the 08th March 1917.



5. **Thomas Connor (O'Connor)** Private 12142, 6th Battalion King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, 27 Low Fold, Middle Road, Westtown, Dewsbury. Killed 12th March 1917



6. **John Henry Holmes**, Private 17111, 2nd Battalion King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, 14 Carlisle St, Batley Carr. Killed 12 March 1917



7. **Milnes Scott**, Private 202283, 1/4 Battalion King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, Rose Cottage 110, Old Bank Top, Earlsheaton, Dewsbury. Killed on 12th March 1917 at Achiet-Le-Petit, Pas de Calais whilst taking part in an advance. Newspaper reports suggest he was killed in January 1917 but the recorded death by the War Graves Commission is 12th March



8. **Allen Aston**, Private 202422, 2/4 King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, 15 Kensington St, Flatts, Dewsbury. Killed in action 13th March 1917



9. **William Chapman**, Private 208108 2/4 King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, 104 Thornton Rd, Thornhill Lees, Dewsbury. Killed on 13th March 1917



10. **Harry Campbell**, Private 108392, Royal Garrison Artillery, 13 Lee Street, Ravensthorpe, Dewsbury. Killed on 20th March 1917 by shellfire



11. **Percy Senior**, Private 201222, 1/4 Essex Regiment 25 Brewery Lane, Thornhill Lees. Killed on 27th March 1917



12. **John Ellis**, Private 242385, York and Lancaster Regiment, Havelock St, Ravensthorpe, Dewsbury. Killed 29th March 1917



13. **Charlie Lee**, Private 30751, King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry, Ravensfield Rd, Dewsbury. Killed 30th March 1917, he and a pal were struck by a single shell



14. **Edward Walter Triffitt**, Military Medal. Driver 780180, Royal Field Artillery, 20a, Staincliffe Rd, Dewsbury. Killed 30th March 1917



15. **Charles William Gallagher**, Serjeant 57600, 8th Battalion King's Own Liverpool Regiment, 2, Thomas St, Batley Carr. Killed on the 31st March 1917
