

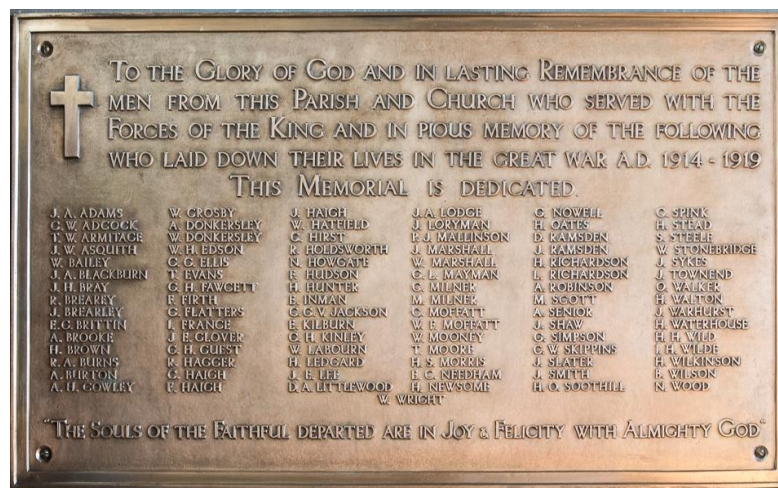

### ANOTHER DEWSBURY SOLDIER KILLED.

Mrs. Haigh, of Victoria Buildings, Leeds Road, Dewsbury, has recently received a letter in which it is stated that her husband, Gunner Charles Haigh (33), R.F.A., was struck by a piece of shrapnel on the 29th November, and died of the wound. Formerly employed by Messrs. Crawshaw and Warburton, and in the evenings by the Dewsbury Empire, as door-keeper, he donned khaki in February of the present year, and arrived in France in August. He received his education at the Eastboro' Council School, and in earlier life was connected with Eastboro' Wesleyan Chapel and Sunday School.
